## Popping the Clutch: (A CarTubers Manual for Love Book 1) Review



This friends-to-lovers, fake relationship, forced proximity, one bed, romcom has all the bells and whistles. I won't lie, I spent several nights staying up way past a reasonable time because the tension and spice were heating up. The author never deviates from the love of cars, which both main characters share, keeping that as a central theme throughout the book, along with several other themes that kept popping up to influence the characters' growth and behavior.

Both main characters grow throughout the book, coming into their own as they discover who they are with each other as well. While Dyson seems light-hearted and easy-going, readers also discover a protective, sexy side of him. Callie, used to being in the background, may just take a step into the spotlight and become a stronger individual.
